General Information:

- Please arrive 10 – 15 minutes early to set up your work station.
- Please bring a task light if you feel you need it.
- Please bring a coffee mug.
- Bring your lunch and a snack. We provide tea and coffee.

Supply List

- sewing machine (in good working order)
- 1/4" foot is recommended
- rotary cutter with mat and 24" ruler (for cutting width of fabric)
- Studio 180 Rapid Fire Hunter's Star (Petite) Tool . If you let the instructor know one month in advance, she will provide the tool for \$33.89 (including HST).
- .7m (3/4 yd) each of two contrasting fabrics (this will make a 20" or 24" square consisting of sixteen 5" or 6" blocks - a 'do-able' size for a one-day workshop)
- pressing station: there will be 4 provided by the Guild and 1 or 2 by the instructor. There will be a fair bit of pressing involved so bring your own ironing tools if you wish.
- the usual basic sewing tools (scissors, stitch ripper, etc.)
